#### Program: The Fentanyl Crisis by District Attorney Brett Ligon; Donna Hansen, division chief; and a mystery guest.

District Attorney Brett Ligon has spent his entire professional career in the area of law enforcement and criminal justice. If asked, he would say that he is most proud of having started at the very bottom entry level as an intern in college with the Brazos County District Attorney's Office, and later as a jailer in the Montgomery County Sheriff's Department. From there, he continued working his way through the ranks as an Assistant District Attorney for the Harris County District Attorney's Office, and Staff Counsel for the Houston Police Officers' Union before finally being elected as the District Attorney of Montgomery County.

Since being elected District Attorney, Brett has carried out his campaign commitment of helping us lose the title of the Deadliest Roadways in Texas by focusing on Driving While Intoxicated offenses. His office has implemented No Refusal Weekends, in which a person suspected of driving while intoxicated has a sample of his blood taken if they refuse to voluntarily give a sample of their breath.

He has also implemented D.A.R.T., the District Attorneys Response Team, which dispatches a team of prosecutors and D.A. investigators to the scene of homicides and traffic fatalities involving alcohol, drugs, or excessive speed.



#### MINUTES OF THE DECEMBER 6 MEETING - Sharon Lasseter, Recording Secretary

The December General Meeting of the North Shore Republican Women was called to order at 11:00 am by Leigh Billingsley, President.



Cheryl Bolt gave the devotional and prayer. Julie Faubel, TFRW Director Senate District 4, led the Pledges of Allegiance. The minutes were approved as presented. Genette Stanton, 2nd Vice President reported on the membership statistics. Since the beginning of this meeting the membership has almost doubled. She, also, discussed online registration and payment methods. Chris Gurley, Treasurer presented the monthly report. The balance on hand on November 30th was \$119,750.05. Chris Gurley presented the proposed 2024 budget. Leigh Billingsley made a motion to accept the 2024 budget as presented. Kim Greene seconded the motion. The 2024 budget was approved.

Kim Greene, Caring for America, Co-chairman, discussed the Blue Elf Christmas project. Chick-Fil-A gift cards and/or cash was collected to provide breakfast for the volunteers. Sheriff Rand Henderson and three officers were recognized and presented a check for \$1000.

Ann South, Caring for America, stated that NSRW is making an impact in Conroe. She reported that 6000 Constitutions and 600 dictionaries have been delivered to students. Ann read cards from students thanking NSRW for providing the dictionaries. People from the Pregnancy Center have, also, sent thank you notes for the help they received from NSRW..

Candidates introduced included Kent Chambers, 9th Court of Appeals,; Kenna Seiler, 9th Court of Appeals; Wesley Doolittle and Rand Henderson, Sheriff.

Deborah Gentz, Campaign Activities Chairman, reminded everyone to submit their volunteer hours.

1st Vice President, Carolyn Jones introduced Cay Eckland, Director of the Chordbusters, a ladies barbershop choir. The Chordbusters presented an entertaining performance of carols, other familiar Christmas songs and a special, humorous arrangement of "The Twelve Days of Christmas."

The meeting was adjourned at 12:40 pm.


