

North Shore Republican Women (NSRW) Scholarship Application Requirements for Montgomery High School & Willis High School Class of 2022. If applicant attends the NSRW sponsored Young Republican Club held within Montgomery County, but attends an alternative schooling high school, they are likewise eligible to apply for scholarship **IF** their home school of record for 2022 graduation is Montgomery High School (MHS) or Willis High School (WHS) AND they met ALL requirements as noted below.

Applicant **MUST** meet ALL requirements:

1. Montgomery High School or Willis High School 2022 graduating seniors are eligible to apply for NSRW scholarship. Likewise, if a student applicant attends an *alternative schooling high school as identified by the Texas Education Agency (TEA) and their home school of record for 2022 graduation is MHS or WHS they are eligible to apply.
2. Applicant must be accepted to attend college in the fall of 2022 and must be scheduled to attend full-time in the fall. Student must provide copy of official letter of acceptance and enrollment from the college.
3. Registered and active member of NSRW's sponsored Montgomery High School or Willis High School Young Republicans clubs, or the NSRW sponsored Montgomery County Young Republican Club. To be considered an active member, students must have attended 75% of all scheduled NSRW Young Republican Club meetings where they are a registered member.
4. Must provide a letter of recommendation from the Young Republican Club's Sponsor attesting to applicant's club attendance and commitment to the republican party.
5. GPA of 3.40 or higher on a 4.0 grade scale. Students enrolled in dual credit courses or advanced placement courses will receive additional consideration.
6. Copy of official high school transcript from 2022 Spring semester.
7. Must provide a photocopy of student's official SAT scores. Other accepted assessments approved for placement to be exempted from SAT may be

provided in the form of a photocopy of student's official TSI/TSIA2 scores.

8. A brief personal interview with the NSRW Scholarship Committee must be held. Interviews may be held virtually or in person.
9. Two letters of recommendation:
 - (a) one from an adult (not a relative) who can attest to your character and interests, and
 - (b) one letter from a different adult who can verify your academic achievements including your GPA. Please do not include "to whom it may concern" form letters.
10. Letter (200 – 250 words typed and double spaced) stating why you think you should be awarded this scholarship.
11. Application and all required documents must be submitted via email to NSRW's Scholarship Committee Chair, Dr. Jacque Lookabaugh at jlookbook@yahoo.com **or** mailed to NSRW Scholarship Chair, P.O. Box 1993, Montgomery, TX 77356. All applications with all required documents **MUST** be received by midnight April 1, 2022. Late applications will not be considered.
